Question 1

What information are we given in the prologue (Rv 1:1-3) and in the opening greeting (Rv 1:4-8)?

Question 2

Describe the circumstances of the vision related in Revelation 1:9-20. What does John hear and see, and what can we understand of these things? (What keys does the Living One hold?—cf. v. 18.)

Question 3

Chapters 2 and 3 consist of seven messages which the Lord entrusts to His servant. Briefly describe the content of the first four (Rv 2), keeping in mind that God's Word is relevant in every age.

Question 2

Describe the vision related in chapter 4. What is taking place in the vision, and of what relevance are the details which the evangelist notes (e.g., the twenty-four elders, the four living creatures, and the rainbow)?

Lesson 3 Revelation 6 – 9

Question 1

Describe the events revealed in chapter 6, when the first six seals of the scroll are broken. Secondly (II), what duty and power have the four angels been given in regard to the end of the world (7:1-2), and what does God command them to do *before* carrying out their task (7:3-8)? Describe the vision which John sees following the instruction to the four angels (7:9-17).

Question 2

What happens once the Lamb breaks the seventh seal (8:1), and what is the duty of the angel with the golden censer (8:3-5)? According to the vision, are we to believe that the incense offered is powerful? How does the vision of the heavenly liturgy relate directly to us who live on earth?

Question 3

Describe the disasters which occur on earth and throughout the universe when the first six trumpets are sounded (8:6-13, 9:1-21). Do these events remind us of similar judgments revealed under the Old Testament? How do those who are not killed by the plagues respond to these events (9:20-21)?

Lesson 4 Revelation 10 – 12

Question 1

Describe the angel who now appears in chapter 10. What does he do and what does he say? (What does his voice sound like?) How can the scroll be both sweet and bitter?

Question 3

After the seventh trumpet is heard and the heavenly temple and ark of the covenant are seen (11:15-19), the "great sign" of the woman appears (12:1). Who is this woman, and what is the significance of the fact that she is in labor (12:2)? What other sign appears in the presence of the woman (12:3)? Describe the battle revealed in chapter 12. Does anyone have definitive victory? Explain your answer. What images are used in 12:14-16?

Question 1

In chapter 12 we learned of the enraged dragon's resolve to make war against the woman's children (12:17). Describe the two beasts revealed in chapter 13. What is their relationship to the dragon and to each other, and what are the fruits of their works? By what number can we recognize the beast (13:18)?

Question 2

Question 3

When the seven angels with the seven plagues appear, what hymn are the saints singing (15:1-4), and what is contained in the seven bowls which the angels are commanded to pour out on the earth (15:7-8, 16:1-12)? How do the people on earth respond to the suffering that comes upon them because of God's justice (16:9,11,21)? What warning does the Word give to the people in Revelation 16:15, and where does Scripture say the armies will be assembled for "the war of the Great Day of God the Almighty" (Rv 16:14-16)? What happens when the seventh bowl is emptied (16:17-21)?

Lesson 6 Revelation 17 – 18

Question 1

Describe the woman revealed in chapter 17. (How is this image similar in language to the way the prophets sometimes speak of God's own People, and why do they speak this way?) Where or upon what is the woman enthroned (17:1,3,9,15), and what kind of wine has made her drunk (17:6)? The author, knowing that the vision's meaning is perplexing to many, states the significance of its figures. What does he say about the woman and her identity (17:5,18), the seven heads (17:9-10), the ten horns (17:12-13), and the waters (17:15)?

Question 2

After the angel announces the fall of Babylon (18:1-3), a voice from heaven calls out to God's People. What are they told (18:4-8)? How does the world respond when it sees God's judgment come upon Babylon (18:9-20), and how does Babylon's judgment conclude (18:21-24)?

Lesson 7 Revelation 19 – 20

Question 1

Describe the vision revealed in 19:1-8. For whom or about whom is this feast? What does the angel command John to record concerning this feast (19:9), and how does John respond to the angel's revelation (19:10)? (Compare 19:10 to 1:17-18.)

Question 3

Secondly (II), what is taking place in the scene described in 20:11-15, and what is the ultimate fate of those whose names are not found written in the Book of Life?

Describe God's holy city, the new Jerusalem (chapter 21:1-20). What does the One sitting on the throne say about this 'new place' (21:5-8)?

Question 4

The last section of Revelation (22:6-21) functions as an epilogue. What does the Lord (i.e., Jesus Himself or the Lord speaking through the angel; cf. 22:6-7,10-16,20) say to us, and what do the Spirit and the Bride say (22:17)?
